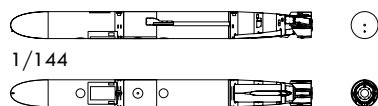


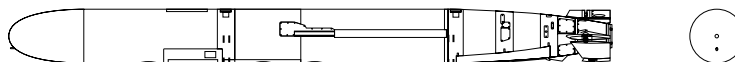

Raduga Kh-55 Cruise Missile



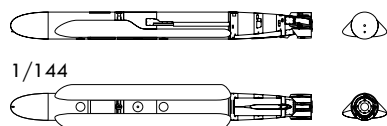

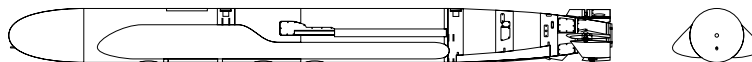

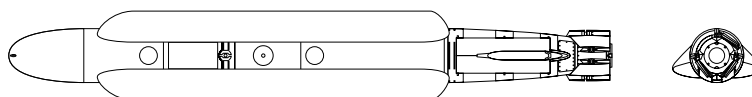
Kh-55SM Extended Range



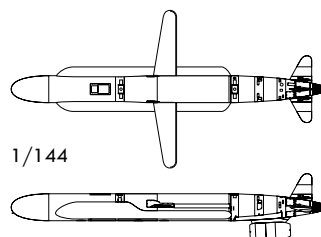

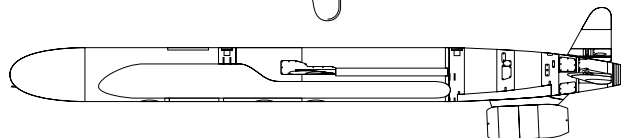
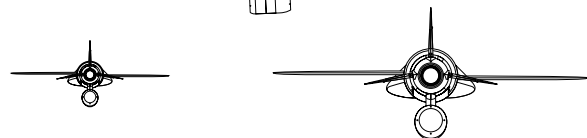
Kh-55SM Flight Mode

The Tupolev Tu-160 is capable of carrying up to 88,180lbs in the two fuselage weapon bays, both of which are equipped with rotary MKU-6-5U launchers. The primary weapon employed is the Raduga Kh-55 (AS-15A *Kent*) or Kh-55SM (AS-15B) extended range cruise missile. Six of these weapons fit on each rotary launcher, with the wings and tails folded, for a total complement of twelve missiles. Alternatively, the Tu-160 can carry a total of 24 Raduga Kh-15S (AS-16 *Kickback*) short-range ASMs, twelve on each rotary launcher. The Kh-55 can also be carried by the Tu-95MS-6, while the Kh-15S is carried by the Tu-22M3 and Tu-9MS-6, in addition to the Tu-160.
